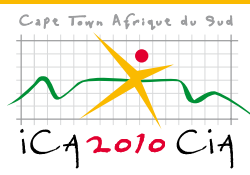

## THE CAPE ARGUS PICK N PAY CYCLE TOUR

ICA 2010 delegates and accompanying persons are eligible to register for limited places in the Cape Argus Pick n Pay Cycle Tour. The tour is the world's largest timed cycle race, and the first event outside of Europe to be included in the International Cycling Union's Golden Bike Series. It sees more than 35,000 cyclists tackling a 109-kilometre route around Cape Town that is as spectacular as it is gruelling.



## A GREEN CONGRESS

*ICA 2010 will endeavour to reduce its environmental footprint through the implementation of a green policy.*

- **Recycling** - Paper, plastic, glass and tins will be recycled.
- **Locally-sourced materials** - Congress materials including the delegate bags and lanyards will be produced locally with an emphasis on local job creation in Cape Town's disadvantaged communities.
- **Delegate handbook** - Printed on "Triple Green" paper produced at the Sappi Stanger Mill in South Africa, one of only a few mills in the world using sugar cane fibre as its primary source of pulp. The pulp is a by-product of the local sugar production and is an annually-renewable resource as well as a recycled raw material.
- **The menu** - All ICA 2010 meals will be designed using local, seasonal produce.
- **The venue** - The Cape Town International Convention Centre has eco-friendly policies in place, including an automated electricity-savings programme to prevent waste by lights, air conditioning and escalators; water-use minimisation systems using drip-flow irrigation and dual-flush toilets; an in-house recycling system; biodegradable cleaning agents; and the sourcing of local supplies to promote job creation and the sustainability of local farms and producers. The building itself achieves 77.1% compliance with the South African Energy and Demand Efficiency Standards.
- **Accommodation** - ICA 2010 congress hotels are encouraged to follow a green policy for the duration of ICA 2010.
- **Renewable energy** - RECs (Renewable Energy Certificates) will be supplied by GreenX Energy in Cape Town. Unlike a carbon trade, a REC does not simply offset carbon emissions (through tree planting, for example) it certifies the sale and use of electricity derived from renewable energy resources and generated sustainably.
